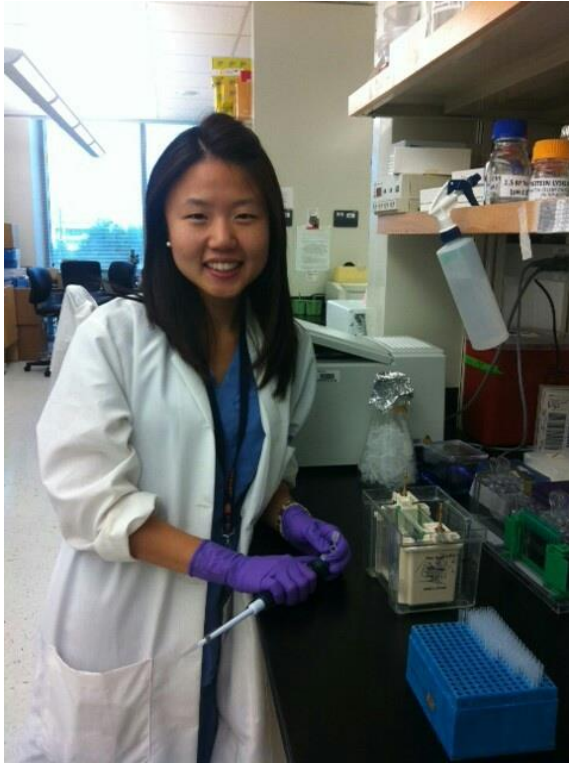


September 2016: Kyulim Lee
